Resolution 2022-36-A Mound Valley Cemetery

Commissioner Cole J. Proehl made a motion for the governing body of the Mound Valley Cemetery to levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 3.122 mills on Resolution 2022-36-A. Terry Weidert seconded the motion. There was not a quorum present from Mound Valley Cemetery so they will not be allowed to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate of 3.122 mills and there was no vote nor signatures on the resolution.

Resolution 2022-37-A Oak Hill Cemetery

Commissioner Cole J. Proehl made a motion for the governing body of the Oak Hill Cemetery to levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 3.406 mills on Resolution 2022-37-A. Terry Weidert seconded the motion. There was not a quorum present from Oak Hill Cemetery so they will not be allowed to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate of 3.406 mills and there was no vote nor signatures on the resolution.

Chairman Lonie R. Addis made a motion to approve the following checks: Accounts Payable check numbers 28515 through 28695 in the amount of \$307,031.33. Terry Weidert seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote: Lonie R. Addis (Yes), Cole J. Proehl (Yes), Terry Weidert (Yes).

Commissioners met for a period of fifteen minutes to reconvene at 11:08 a.m. in the commission room.

Temporary Vacation Policy
