Alphonso Johnson – Discussion

Alphonso Johnson talked to Commissioners about a traffic ticket he received from the City of Parsons concerning a faulty brake light. The brake light was fixed and the ticket was dismissed but he is still being charged \$15. Mr. Johnson was just asking Commissioners if they could help explain to him why the Parsons Municipal Court could do so. USD 506

Dr. John Wyrick, Superintendent of USD 506, formally introduced the new USD 506 Assistant Superintendent Tony Blackwell to the Commissioners.
