## Voter Registration

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) years of age and upwards or will have attained the age of eighteen (18) years at the next election, must register before he or she may vote.

When a voter has been registered according to law his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

- 1. The Voter changes residence, outside of his/her voting precinct boundary.
- 2. The Voter fails to vote in two consecutive state general elections.

If either of the above occurs, you must re-register. Any person may apply in person or by mail to the County Election Officer to re-register. The application shall be signed under penalty of perjury.

### **CLOSING OF REGISTRATION BOOKS**

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-2310 & K.A.R 7-23-4, notice is hereby given that on the 18th day of October 2022 registration books for the National/State/County General Election will close at the end of the business day (last day to register to vote). The books will remain closed until the day following the General Election, November 9, 2022.

# ADVANCE VOTING by MAIL: KSA25-1123

Any registered voter is eligible to vote by Advance Ballot, beginning Wednesday October 19, 2022 (20 days prior to said General Election). **Monday, November 1, 2022 is the last day voters may apply for Advance Ballots for General Election** per KSA25-1122(e)(4). Applications for Advance Ballots are available at the Labette County Clerk/Election Office or by calling (620) 795-2138. Returning Advance Ballots: In Person: Ballots must be returned by 7:00 P.M. on Election Day to any Polling Location within the County or to the County Election Office, Courthouse, 501 Merchant, Oswego, KS 67356.

By Mail: Ballot must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, November 8, 2022 (Election Day) and received in County Election Office by Friday, November 11, 2022 the deadline for receipt of Advance Ballots. KSA 25-1132
