A RESOLUTION OF LABETTE COUNTY, KANSAS TO EXCEED THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE IN ITS PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE TAX YEAR OF 2022

WHEREAS, the Labette County Board of County Commissioners is statutorily required to provide notice and hearing prior to exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Labette County Clerk provided notice of the hearing on the Revenue Neutral Rate on July 20, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for tax year 2021 for Labette County was calculated as 61.536 mills by the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Labette County Board of County Commissioners for tax year 2022 will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Labette County Board of County Commissioners having heard testimony, have determined that it is in the best interests of Labette County to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LABETTE COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Labette County shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate of 60.942 mills for Tax Year 2022.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Labette County Board of County Commissioners.
